The meeting started with the group saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Lynn asked for any public comment related to the agenda items. No comments.

Police Chief Fred Dyroff:

Chief Dyroff asked the board to approve hiring Dale Houser, Jr. as a part time police officer, upon receiving Act 57 clearance from MPOETC. This was approved and advertised in September of 2022. **Supervisor Whelan motioned to approve the hire of Dale Houser, Jr and Chairman Lynn seconded. Motion passed.**

Chief Dyroff presented DSI Lead Lloyd Craig and his team with a plaque and a gift card for the Galera Restaurant for their hard work and dedication during the remodel of the police department.

Treasurer Ken Houck was not available.

Engineer Drew Barton:

Engineer Barton gave a brief overview of the possible plans for the Whisper Hills Storm Water project for resident Jon Eckhart and said we need to determine going forward how to administer these funds.

Solicitor Jonathan DeWald was not available.

Zoning Officer Dean VonBlohn had nothing to report.

DSI Lead Lloyd Craig gave his report:

Lloyd said they had to replace three signs that were vandalized on the Red Lane area.

Lloyd said he is working on prices to replace the street light pole that rusted on the river bridge and will have more information at the next meeting. The township is responsible for (6) of the lights.

Lloyd said paving bids are being advertised and are scheduled to open on March 13th.

Lloyd confirmed from unfinished business at the last meeting that we get the same price on aggregates whether we go out on our own for pricing or go through Co-stars. We actually save money by going through Costars because we don't have to advertise.

Lloyd said since we are removing the Villa Street paving, he would like to use some of the money to replace guiderails on Clinic Road. The board approved getting prices.

Fire Chief Leslie Young gave the 2022 Year-End Report and gave her monthly report.

Fire Chief Young's year-end report will be posted on the website tomorrow.

Supervisor Neuner thanked the East End Fire Company for the outstanding job they do.
