ENGINEER'S REPORT: Engineer's Report for October was submitted and required the following action by the Board:

TRAFFIC STUDY: By motion of Mr. Myers, second Mr. Barron, the Board granted approval for Uni-Tec Engineering to conduct a traffic study of the roads on Sidler Hill; H Eyer, Lower, Middle, Upper & Reservior.
