

**March 13, 2023, Meeting Minutes- held at the Mahoning Township Building, 849 Bloom Road, Danville, PA, at 5:30pm**

The meeting started with the group saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Chairman Lynn asked for any public comment related to the agenda items. No comments.**

**Police Chief Fred Dyroff**

Police Chief Dyroff gave his report.

Chief Dyroff said Part-Time Officer Dale Houser started work last week but will need 160 hours of training before he can go out on a shift by himself.

Chief Dyroff said they had a mock assessment today for preparation of accreditation. They need to make a few minor adjustments before the real assessment which will be sometime in mid-May. His goal is to receive full accreditation by this July.

**Solicitor Jonathan DeWald**

Solicitor DeWald discussed the public hearing meeting held right before this meeting, relative to the restaurant liquor license transfer between municipal boundaries, license # R21042. This license is to be transferred into Mahoning Township to be owned by Galera Dos Mexican Restaurant, LLC. Solicitor DeWald would like to execute Resolution #2023-0313, still subject to final approval from the PLCB. **Supervisor Whelan motioned to adopt Resolution 2023-0313 as summarized by the solicitor. Supervisor Cromley seconded. Motion passed.**

**Supervisor Whelan motioned to award the paving bid contract to HRI, for \$147,805.50, pending final review by the solicitor to make sure they are compliant with all our requirements.**

**Supervisor Neuner seconded. Motion passed.**

**Treasurer Ken Houck**

Ken gave the February treasurers report – **Supervisor Cromley motioned to approve the February treasurers report. Supervisor Whelan seconded. Motion passed.**

**Engineer Drew Barton was not available.**

**Zoning Officer Dean VonBlohn**

Dean said they have (2) new homes in the township that should break ground soon and (1) in Cooper Township.

**Chairman Lynn spoke on behalf of DSI Lead Lloyd Craig, who was not available.**

Chairman Lynn said Lloyd received (2) street sweeping quotes:

- Don E. Bower for \$177.50 per hour
- Robert C. Young for \$194.00 per hour.

**Supervisor Whelan motioned to accept the bid from Don E Bower at 177.50/hour. Supervisor Neuner seconded. Motion passed.**

**Fire Chief Leslie Young**

Fire Chief Young gave the February fire report.

Fire Chief Young discussed the St. Patrick's Day Dance coming up this Friday, March 17<sup>th</sup>, from 8pm to 11pm. Must be at least 21 years old to attend.
