

June 24, 2024, Meeting Minutes- held at the Mahoning Township Building, 849 Bloom Road, Danville, PA, at 5:30pm

The meeting started with the group saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Lynn asked for any public comment related to the agenda items. No comment.

Solicitor Jonathan DeWald had nothing to discuss.

Zoning Officer Dean VonBlohn:

New Business:
