

May 13, 2024, Meeting Minutes- held at the Mahoning Township Building, 849 Bloom Road, Danville, PA, at 5:30pm

The meeting started with the group saying the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairman Lynn asked for any public comment related to the agenda items. No comment.

Police Chief Fred Dyroff gave his report and discussed:

Chief Dyroff briefly discussed the joint aggressive driving enforcement detail his department took part in and said another enforcement detail will be completed between May 13-June 2, 2024.

Chief Dyroff discussed the training some of the officers participated in since the last meeting.

Chief Dyroff said the summer intern, Alli Lunger, started her internship today.

Treasurer Ken Houck gave his April report:

Ken gave the April Treasurers report. **Supervisor Whelan motioned to approve the April Treasurers report. Supervisor Cromley seconded. Motion passed.**

Ken said that liquid fuels money is in Plgit now.

Ken said the winner of the old drone sold on Municibid is James Robert from Moscow, PA, for \$2,500. Ken said he has 10 days to appear here at the township to receive the drone, with a cashier's check or cash. **Chairman Lynn motioned to accept the bid for \$2,500 from James Robert. Supervisor Whelan seconded. Motion passed.**

Ken asked the board to approve the release of money from (4) escrow accounts, for projects that are now complete. Koltenuk for \$5,420, Danko Holding for \$537.50, Danville Boro for \$123.75 and Montour County for \$155.00. **Supervisor Whelan motioned to return the escrow funds as outlined by our treasurer. Supervisor Lynn seconded. Motion passed.**

Chairman Lynn said Engineer Barton will discuss the Villa Street Water replacement at the next meeting.

Solicitor Jonathan DeWald had nothing to discuss.

Zoning Officer Dean VonBlohn:
