The following is a summary of the activities of the Mahoning Township Fire Department for the year 2025.

INCIDENT SUMMARY

In the year 2025, we were dispatched to 240 incidents. This was an 8.9% increase from 218 incidents in 2024, Personnel hours on incidents was 1536 man hours. We responded to 127 incidents in Mahoning Township and provided aid on 113 incidents in twenty-five different municipalities. We actively were involved in extinguishing 25 fires in 2025. 7 of those fires were in Mahoning Township. There were no injuries to firefighters reported as a result of incident response. The average number of firefighters per call was 7. This is the same as the previous five years. For “Lights and Sirens” incidents, the average response time from dispatch to enroute was 05:05 (MM: SS) and average response time from dispatch to arrival on scene was 8:36 (MM: SS).

TRAINING

We had 24 in-house training sessions and several members participated in certified training courses. Members spent 1020 hours on training in 2025. An average of 12 members attended the in-house training sessions. No injuries were reported during training activities. The highlight of the year being the live burn conducted in November.



FIRE PREVENTION

Fire Prevention activities were again accomplished, which included Preschools and Daycares, schools and Fire Drills/Inspections for businesses.

INCREASED FUNDING AND SUPPORT

None of this progress would be possible without the funding and support from our community and local government, the leadership of the East End Fire Company (EEFC) and East End Auxiliary have worked tirelessly to improve the social services provided over the course of the last year.

Support from our local government in the form of covering fuel expenses, and the support provided in your FY 2026 budget will continue to have a significant positive impact on our ability to provide services to the community and equip firefighters with the latest technology.

In addition, The Mahoning Township Fire Department receives funding from the Mahoning Township Volunteer Firemen's Relief Association (MTVFRA) which supports training and equipment such as the replacement and maintenance of our self-contained breathing apparatus air cylinder compressor. We continue to strive to place approximately 50% of the Mahoning Township Fire Tax into an apparatus replacement fund. This amounts to between \$30,000 - \$40,000 yearly.

LOOKING AHEAD

As we turn the page on 2025 and step into 2026, I want to sincerely thank everyone who contributes to the strength of our fire company and our community. The accomplishments of the past year reflect what is possible when we move forward together.

To our firefighters, I am deeply grateful for your dedication, bravery, and service. To your families, thank you for the constant encouragement and support you provide to those who answer the call. To our local officials, thank you for your continued commitment to the volunteer fire company and its role in safeguarding our town. And to our community, thank you for your trust, involvement, and shared vision of a safer tomorrow.
